Pastor's Perspectives

Next Sunday is **Palm Sunday** so we will begin in the Gathering Space and process together into the Worship Space.

The **Sacrament of Reconciliation** will be available next Saturday from 4:00-4:40 PM and on Tuesday, April 11th from 6:00 to at least 7:00 PM.

What Makes us Unique as Catholics our next LIFE Event is this Sunday and Wednesday, April 2nd and 5th. You can still sign up for Wednesday night.

The Holiest 3 days of the Year, the Easter Triduum ("Three Days") begins with Holy Thursday Mass at 7:00 PM on April 13 and continues on Good Friday at 7:00 PM and reaches its climax with the Holy Saturday Night Vigil at 8:00 PM. These are the great liturgies of Holy week that tell the story of the Last Supper as well as Christ's death and resurrection. This is the ultimate story of God's love poured out for us and victorious in both the cross and resurrection. Make plans to join us and make a mini-retreat through these liturgies. Easter Sunday Masses will be at 7:00, 9:00 and 11:00 AM.

Our first Annual Fund project of replacing the wallpaper in the Worship Space with tile is mostly complete (there are a few special areas we will do later). Next, we will do the ceiling tile and lights in the south side of the Gathering Space and also reuse some of that tile to fix the ceiling on the north side of the Gathering Space. So you may see the Gathering Space ceiling half done or in process during the next two or three weeks.

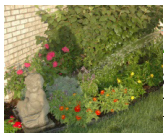
