Pastor's Perspectives

Our Holy Week liturgies remind us who we are.

On **Holy Thursday**, (7 p.m.) we remember our call to serve one another and wash one another's feet. We remember Christ's amazing gift of His Body and Blood and are inspired to give our lives in service to one another. For those who wish, we end the evening in adoration in the Ville until 10 p.m., where we stay with Christ, remembering his prayer in the garden before his arrest.

On **Good Friday**, (7 p.m.) we remember Jesus Christ's passion and death and how much God loves us. We pray for our world and we receive that love of Christ in his Body and Blood.

At the **Holy Saturday Night Vigil**, (8 p.m.) we gather with those preparing to join the Church to remember how Christ brings light to the darkest corners of our world. We remember the bigger story of God creating, calling and liberating his people from the beginning of time. We remember Jesus Christ's resurrection from the dead and are renewed along with those being baptized in the waters of baptism, recalling our own baptism and God's life within us. We also pray that the Holy Spirit will descend upon those being confirmed and fill them and our Church with that new life of the Spirit. Finally, we celebrate how the risen Christ is with us now in the Eucharist.

Easter Sunday continues the celebration of Christ's resurrection from the dead, remembering on Easter and every Sunday how the risen Christ still comes to be with us in the Eucharist we share. Easter Sunday Masses will be 7, 9 and 11 a.m.

Stations of the Cross will be at 3 p.m. on Good Friday.
