We will meet May 30th as usual.

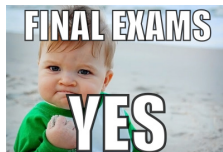

Friday, June 2; 11:15 a.m. Little children and their caregivers are welcome to this very special daily Mass tailored especially for the little ones among us. No charge.

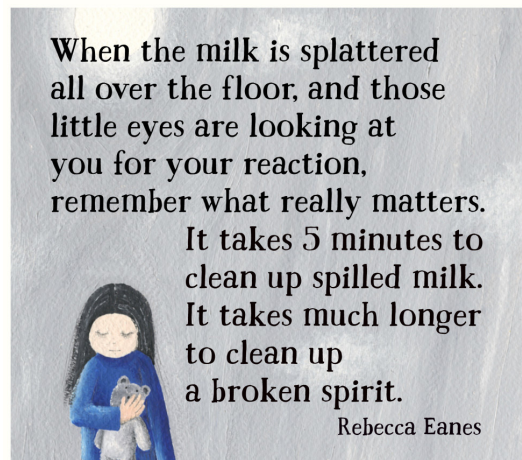
SERIES: FIGHTING FOR YOUR MARRIAGE (4 Mondays)
