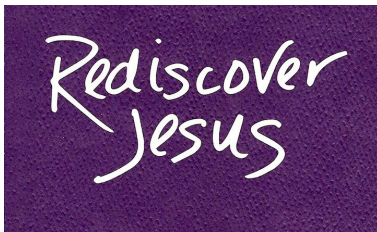




Join us for our **January LIFE Event** as we welcome guest speaker, Matt Vainer. Matt will give the adult presentation about "Being the Church in a
