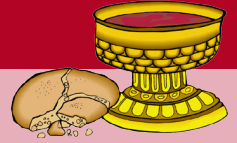
I want to celebrate the Middle School Lock-in last Friday night. About 140 middle school kids were here and had a great experience where faith was mixed in with lots of fun. The middle school kids were great. I want to thank all the high school and college aged kids that helped out and the adults who provided the necessary supervision. I especially want to thank Michelle Wagle, our MS Youth Minister who did such a great job organizing the event and all the volunteers and youth.

Our High School Youth and leaders have begun planning to install a sand volleyball court on our property in the area north of the rectory. We currently are not using that area for anything other than growing weeds. I think this will be a great addition since we do not have a gym available for physical activities. There will be some cost for the sand and other miscellaneous supplies. We will be putting some items up on the GO board in the coming weeks. Our parish loan is now under \$200,000 after the May payment. This loan was taken out during the construction of the Ville and would have been paid off, except for the need to delay payments to replace the roof of the Church. The loan is scheduled to be paid off in October of 2015.
