Stewardship – "Who are You Following?"

Today's readings seems to be addressing a ministerial problem: power and arrogance. Malachi speaks to the priests of old and Jesus speaks of the Scribes and Pharisees. In both cases, the message is clear: do not mislead the flock. Throughout history, we have seen what happens when religious leaders become prideful and make poor choices. However, most of us are not religious leaders - we are the lay people. Are we off the hook? Do not be mistaken we, too, are in positions of leadership. We are parents. We are teachers. We are lay ministers. We are called to practice what we preach. We are called to set an example in the life we lead. We are called to serve God and to serve one another. So perhaps the questions we should all consider today are these: Who is following YOU, and where are you leading them?

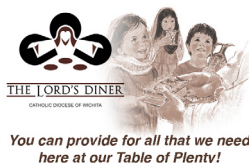
