**Pastor's Perspectives**

An **Active Shooter Training session** will be held here at St. Vincent's this Monday, April 16th at 7 p.m. in the Ville. We are encouraging ushers to attend and all interested parishioners are invited. The training will be offered by Chris McAuliffe, a parishioner and Wichita police officer, who has done this training many times before. He will teach people how to react to an active shooter situation whether that is here at St. Vincent's or elsewhere.

It is extremely unlikely that we will have an active shooter situation here at St. Vincent's. We must not give into unreasonable fear and let it steal our sense of hospitality. Therefore, I do not want to turn the building into an armed camp or have security at every door. However, it is good to have an awareness of how to respond. Everyone should be aware of where the exits are in the unlikely event of a fire or another emergency. So come and find out on April 16th. Childcare available.

**Good Wine ministry** for our senior parishioners is this Thursday at 11 a.m. I will be talking about Pope Francis' new Apostolic Exhortation on "The Call to Holiness in Today's World." Two initial thoughts: first I am sure Pope Francis' advice will be practical; secondly, it is only 40 pages long, which is rather amazing for a pope to keep this type of a teaching document that short.
