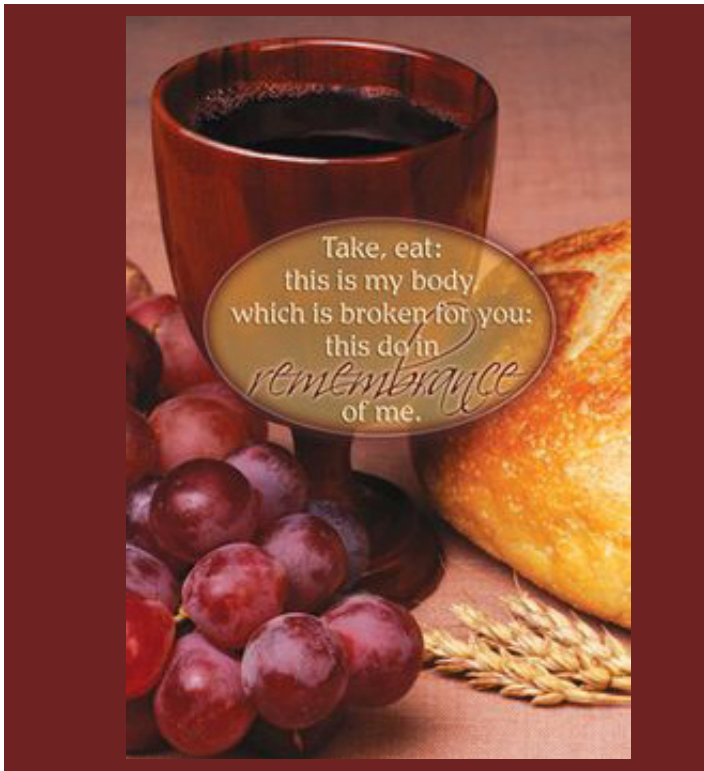

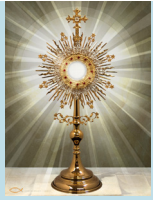

The Eucharist demands our utmost respect and reverence, both in our making time for the Eucharist and through reverence in our celebration of the Eucharist. Our reverence for Christ in the Eucharist also should lead us to greater reverence and respect for our brothers and sisters. Christ's presence leads us to reverence, whether that is in the Eucharist or his presence in other people.

The Eucharistic fast is one way we show respect for the importance of what we are doing. We fast for an hour before communion as a way to prepare ourselves for what we are to receive. It's not meant to be a barrier to receiving communion, but instead reverent preparation. Do not focus on when you ate last. Instead focus on the Eucharist. Recognize the value of this reverent gesture that makes us mindful and helps us prepare to receive Christ even before we arrive in Church.
