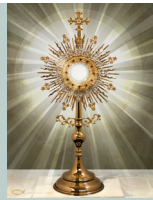

for both the handicapped and the children. This location is next to the other restrooms and plumbing so it is an obvious choice. However, there will be some inconvenience once work starts because it is so close to the other restrooms. Therefore we want to be able to do it as quickly as possible.

Stewardship – “Who Are You Following?”

The reading from Mark's Gospel reveals a less-than-inspiring theme of rejection. Not even the Son of God was immune to rejection -- He received it from the Jews, from religious and political leaders, from some of His followers, and as we see today, from His own family. But a second look at today's Gospel also reveals a new definition of love and what it means to be family. In Mark 3:34-35, Jesus says, "Here are my mother and my brothers. For whoever does the will of God is my brother and sister and mother." As followers of Jesus Christ, we are counted among His brothers and sisters -- His family. The heart of a steward casts off rejection and seeks the will of God by reaching out to others in love and in service.
