Pastor's Perspectives

Faith formation registration is now. Registration is ongoing for all our programs for grades K-5. The first session for First Communion/Reconciliation is next Sunday so register now.

We intentionally do not have traditional PSR Classes on Wednesday nights because all the studies have shown they do not work. Instead, we have Faith Formation programs that include: LIFE events for the whole family, Small Groups for K-5, First Communion/Reconciliation classes that include the parents, and Breakfast of Champions for grades 3-5 and their families. Middle school students are encouraged to attend Edge on Tuesday nights and High school students have LIFE Teen on Wednesday nights.

We believe these programs offer our youth better and more effective faith formation. Our programs for K-5 intentionally involve the parents because parents must be involved for faith formation to be effective. These programs are a lot more work for us and a little more complicated to get signed up, but the positive response of children and families make it worthwhile. Sign up now.

Interested in joining the Catholic Church? Sign up now or call the office and talk to Teresa. Also talk to her if you are an adult who has not received Confirmation. Finally, we use the same process for older children (grade 4 and above) who have not received First Communion. For those interested in the Catholic Church, there is no commitment. You are invited to come and learn more and discover if God is calling you to become Catholic.

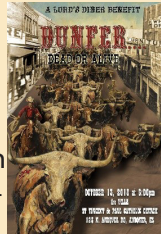
