Pastor's Perspectives

Our first **LIFE Event** on **St. Paul** is today, **Sunday, Oct 7th at 4:45 p.m. (children welcome)** and the following **Wednesday, Oct 10th at 5:45 p.m. (adults only)**. St. Paul was the second most influential person on Christianity behind Jesus Christ. The whole family is welcome on Sundays with special breakouts for children. We even have childcare for the smallest children. Wednesday is for adults only.

The **Lord's Diner Benefit** is next weekend on Oct. 12-13th. It is an event we are proud to sponsor and host. Over the past several years, it has raised well more than \$1 million for the Lord's Diner. If you still want to attend, call Michele in the office.

Bishop Gerber's earthly death is a time for us to remember and give thanks for all that he brought to the diocese. He created a culture of stewardship and encouraged all Catholics to be actively involved in their parishes by sharing their time and talents. He also created the culture that nourished vocations to the priesthood. Bishop Jackels did much to build on that culture, but we already had a large number of seminarians during Bishop Gerber's time. Bishop Gerber also was the inspiration behind the Catholic Life Center and the Spiritual Life Center, which reflected his passion for spirituality and retreats as well as his desire for the Church to be a model in care of the elderly. He also deepened ties between Newman University and the diocese and helped develop the University. Finally, he started the Lord's Diner and
