Pastor's Perspectives

Wear Red next Sunday on Palm Sunday. We will begin our liturgy next Saturday/Sunday in the Gathering Space and process into the Worship Space together as is our custom on Palm Sunday.

Holy Week Liturgies will be Holy Thursday and Good Friday at 7 p.m., Holy Saturday night at 8:30 p.m., and Easter Sunday at 9 a.m. and 11 a.m. We also will have Stations of the Cross on Good Friday at 3 p.m. The Holy Saturday Night Vigil is a half hour later than normal because Easter is so late in the year and we are not allowed to start the Vigil until it is getting close to dark. The Holy Saturday Vigil however is the great celebration of Easter in the Catholic Church. Our regular Saturday evening confessions and Mass at 5 p.m. are not permitted this night.
