**Pastor's Perspectives**

The skylight above the Ville entrance has been causing a number of problems. The most immediate problem is leaks because the rubber seals are old. The leaks have caused problems with both the inside and outside walls. The longer-term problems are glare from the sun and it is impossible to heat and cool that space even with 12 tons of air conditioning. The biggest problem with heating and cooling is the simple fact that the skylight is about 20 by 20 feet, which is a lot of glass. The good news is we have some funds available from the Annual Fund to solve this problem.

The easy solution is to install white frosted glass with new seals that would fix the leak and solve most of the glare issues. We are now getting a bid to replace the glass. However, we still would have problems with heating and cooling. So I am asking the help of any parishioners with expertise for their ideas. I also would love good contacts with contractors that might know how to solve these problems. Please contact me in the office or at [kent@svdpks.org](mailto:kent@svdpks.org).

One idea we have come up with is to reduce the size of the actual window area to the center square part of the structure, which would still be about 7 by 7 feet (49+ square feet of glass rather than 400+ square feet of glass). We then could put a slanted false ceiling below. This would allow us to put a white metal roof on the part that does not have glass and would help with leaks

long term. Since glass is very heavy, this solution also would reduce the weight on the structure. The biggest challenge to this solution would be to find a roofer that does metal roofing, works with glass, and could do the flashings right at the top. So let me know if you have any other ideas, or know of any contractors that might help us figure out this problem.

**Stewardship – “Fully Alive as Missionary Disciples”**

Today we again reflect on our baptism in the Holy Spirit, which urges us to proclaim “Jesus is Lord!” The reading from 1 Corinthians points out that while we are all baptized Missionary Disciples, we certainly are not all called to do the same work! There are different gifts and different forms of service, but they all serve the same Lord! Don’t ever look at your gift as something that isn’t beneficial to the whole group! It is possible that your actions may enable someone else’s actions! Share the gifts you have, and pray that God will multiply your offering in the same way He did the fishes and loaves ... making more than enough to go around. Being a good steward is not contingent upon having more than others; it boils down to sharing whatever it is that you have. Today we celebrate Pentecost—the definitive arrival of the Holy Spirit. Allow yourself to be overcome by the Spirit and give of yourself like you have never given before!



**Hospitality at Mass: A Key to Good Stewardship**

- Summer travel may mean new visitors to our parish for weekend liturgies. Providing hospitality to strangers is a hallmark of Christian stewardship.

In the Gospel of Matthew, good stewards were commended for their hospitality: “I was a stranger and you welcomed me” (Matthew 25:35). Extending hospitality is especially important when it comes to welcoming visitors who may be attending Mass at our parish for the first time. The ability of a first-time visitor to have a meaningful experience of Christ in the liturgy is directly impacted by the warmth of the welcome extended by the local worshipping community. When people say hello, the worship experience is enhanced. A warm welcome is part of evangelization. Take time to welcome visitors to our parish this summer. Welcoming gestures, however small, will not only have a positive impact on visitors, they will make us more hospitable ambassadors of Christ.
