Family movie night is July 12 with food starting at 7 p.m. and the movie starting around 8 p.m. All are welcome so invite friends and neighbors to come for a free and fun movie with the kids. Spiderman will be our movie this month.

Notify us about homebound and hospitalized parishioners. I would love to be able to visit them and bring them communion at home if needed. Only rarely do we receive a name from the hospital so we need you to let us know if you or your loved one would like a visit. Since hospital stays are often so short, home visits have become more important. Finally, do not worry if your home is cluttered and not perfectly clean. Neither is mine. I take communion and anoint the sick and elderly in homes the first Friday of the month and other ministers do so on the other Fridays.

Kidville, our childcare for Masses, will not be available during the month of July. The diocese require us to have at least two adults (over 18) present when we offer childcare. Last year, in July, we were not able to schedule enough adult workers to cover the Masses. So, unfortunately, we cannot offer childcare this July as well. We would like to have more adults help with Kidville and we pay our Kidville helpers. So please apply at the office if you are interested in being part of this ministry.

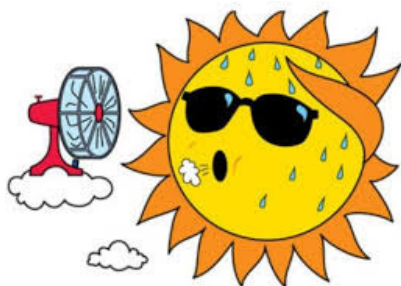
### MARRIAGES
