Pastor's Perspectives

Faith Formation registration for children (K-5) and those to be confirmed begins this weekend and continues through the month of August. There are no fees so act now. Check out the table in the Gathering Space or the website or call the office for more information.

Confirmation age has been changed by the diocese and will eventually be done in 6th- 7th grades. As part of the transition to younger ages, we will have Confirmation for grades 7-12 this year. Two years from now we will move the ages down to 6th-8th grades. We will continue to use small groups, which will help us in this transition period to offer age-appropriate groups.

We need volunteers to lead our Confirmation groups. We currently use a program developed by Matthew Kelly, which has the advantage of using short videos to provide the content. Therefore, the group leaders are more group facilitators than teachers of content.

The Bell Tower is finally finished after being damaged by the wind. Fortunately, insurance covered everything but the \$500 deductible.

Our Annual Fund projects are in the process of being completed. We have completed the tile in the Gathering Space to replace the worn wallpaper. The parking lot repair and sealing should happen in the next week or two depending on the weather. We have a contract signed to replace the movable partition between the

Social Space and Gathering Space and should come in during the next two or three weeks. We will replace the remaining vinyl windows on the ground floor including two windows in the Gathering Space and eight windows around the educational wing. The new boilers are here and waiting to be installed in the next few weeks. And we are planning to install a new tile floor in 1A to replace the worn and badly stained carpet. So we have a lot of projects in process that will be completed soon. Thank you for your generosity that allows us to care for our building.

I'm on vacation this week but will return for Masses next weekend. Fr. Pat Malone will be here for the Holy Day Masses this Thursday at 8 a.m. and 6 p.m.

Stewardship – “Fully Alive as Missionary Disciples”

In today’s Gospel reading, Jesus concludes his teaching about those who are “faithful and prudent stewards” with that classic stewardship teaching: “Much will be required of the person entrusted with much, and still more will be demanded of the person entrusted with more.” Christian stewards recognize that God is the ultimate source of their gifts, talents, resources and aptitudes, and that God wants them to use these varied gifts in his service. This week might be a good time to reflect on our God-given gifts. Are we using those gifts to serve the Lord? If Christ came back to us unexpectedly tomorrow would we be able to give a full accounting of how we have exercised stewardship over these gifts?

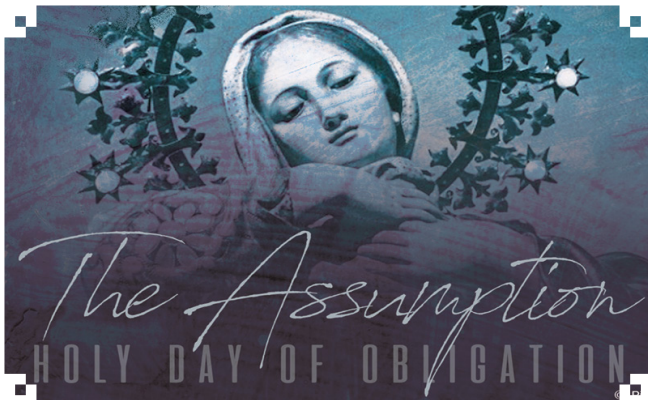
