



10-2 The Four Last Things According To St. Alphonsus Tuesday, July 2, 10:00am - 2:00pm - Fr. Andrew Walsh

In this 10 to 2, we will look at what St. Alphonsus Ligouri has to say about Death, Judgment, Heaven, and Hell – sometimes called the Four Last Things. Through his insights and inspired words, we will seek what St. Alphonsus refers to as the two graces most necessary for the attainment of eternal salvation: namely the graces of perseverance and of divine love. Along the way we'll also consider his teaching on prayer, on Marian devotion, and on praying for the Holy Souls in Purgatory. \$25 per person, lunch is included.
