





Calling all high schoolers! In our ever-changing world, Jesus is the answer to the longing of our hearts for meaning, fulfillment, security, and love.


Join hundreds of Catholic teens this summer at Steubenville Mid-America at Missouri State University on July 16-19 to be transformed by the love of Christ.

Question:

I have heard that Chapters and Verses were not part of the bible until much later. Who added these?

Answer:

You are correct. Modern and very helpful devices such as the enumeration of chapters and verses are not part of the original biblical text. These helpful conventions were added much later. The setting of the biblical text into chapters occurred the 13th century when the Catholic Archbishop of Canterbury, Stephen Langton assigned chapter numbers in order to make the reading of the Bible easier. The numeration of the text into verses did not happen until 1551 Robert Stephanus, a Protestant former Catholic, classical scholar and also a printer, published the first such Bible in Paris.



World Youth Day 2027 will be held in Seoul, South Korea and the Diocese of Wichita is planning to go! This trip will be for all young adults aged 18 (by Summer 2027) - 35 and will include the trip to World Youth Day, as well as a Venerable Emil Kapaun Pilgrimage.
